Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Screening Determination

Pursuant to the requirements of the above, Dublin City Council is proposing an amendment of the approved Part 8 Application ref. 3196/19, to facilitate necessary upgrades and alterations to Dublin City Gallery, The Hugh Lane ('Hugh Lane Gallery'), a Protected Structure (RPS no. 6382).

The proposed works involve the construction of a new internal link connecting the Hugh Lane Gallery to the New Library at 23 to 28 Parnell Square (all connected Protected Structures), and the relocation of the previously proposed Energy Centre for the Hugh Lane Gallery into a combined Energy Centre for the overall Parnell Cultural Quarter site which comprises the Hugh Lane Gallery and the proposed Library.

Following a preliminary examination of the proposed development, Dublin City Council concludes that, by reason of the nature, scale and location of the subject site, the proposed development would not be likely to have significant effects on the environment. Dublin City Council concludes, therefore, that an environmental impact screening report for the proposed development is not necessary in this case nor is an Environmental Impact Assessment to be conducted.
