As a resident of Dublin 8 I am deeply concerned about the proposed variation to the Dublin City Development Plan 2016 - 2022 for developments on Marrowbone Lane.

My reasons for concern include:

The lack of community consultation.

The lack of a democratic process

The lack of quality green space. We do not want just green washing.

The need to ensure this area is able to grow as a community with proper facilities. This proposal runs counter to that.

The need to ensure that there is green space for sporting and community recreational purposes. As it stands there is no adequate sporting infrastructure for the young people in this area in terms of providing key prevention activities like team sports etc.

My view is that the proposal to provide a super depot should not be accepted and a revised variation to provide primarily for housing and other facilities and much needed open space must be considered.
