


SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL

GLASNEVIN NS PARENT SURVEY RESULTS

Results of Our Parent Survey

Responses received: 40 Students represented: 59

Our school has been selected to participate in the Safe Routes to School (SRTS) programme. The objective of the programme is to improve safety at the school gate and to support students to safely walk, cycle and scoot to school. Our Parent Survey results and support for the SRTS programme is showcased below.



80.0% of parents agreed that road safety is a problem around the school


92.5% of parents would support works at the front of school that improve student safety, putting pedestrians and cyclists first

95.0% of parents would support works that improve the walking and cycling routes to our school

Some Key Comments Received from Parents

"It would be great if we had the coloured bollards and road markings like other schools in the area. This would help with safety outside of the school. Also, more incentive for cycling and walking would be appreciated."

"Sometimes cycle to school, but cycle facilities on Ballymun Road and Mobhi Road are limited and very busy. Do not feel comfortable with children on the bus/cycle lane, so they are on the footpaths. Limited safe crossings along Mobhi Road for pedestrians/ cyclists."


