

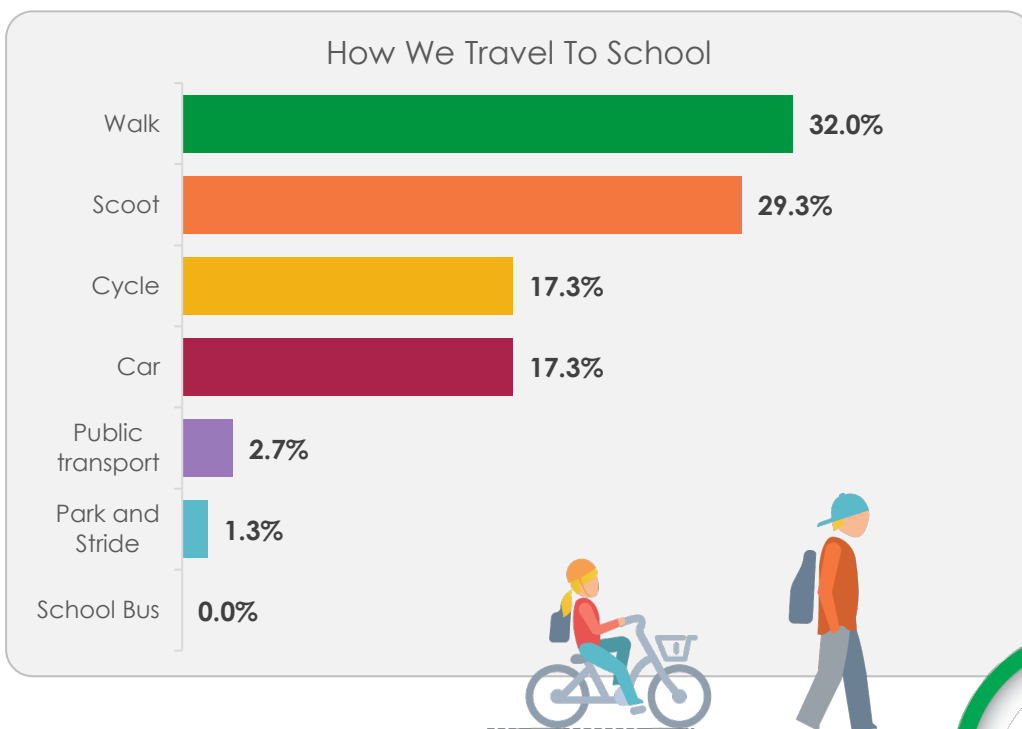
SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL

Results of Our Parent Survey

Responses received: 44 Students represented: 75

Our school has been selected to participate in the Safe Routes to School (SRTS) programme. The objective of the programme is to improve safety at the school gate and to support students to safely walk, cycle and scoot to school. Our Parent Survey results and support for the SRTS programme is showcased below.



72.7% of parents agreed that road safety is a problem around the school

97.7% of parents would support works at the front of school that improve student safety, putting pedestrians and cyclists first

100.0% of parents would support works that improve the walking and cycling routes to our school

Some Key Comments Received from Parents

"I would support no traffic turn down Oakley road between 8.15 and 9am. Residents of the road would still be able to leave going north - but this would mean that parents dropping to school in car would need to park further away."

"Cycle lanes on busy roads would make cycling much safer and more appealing as a mode of transport. For example, the Lower Churchtown Road is in dire need of a cycle lane."

86.4% want new or improved cycle paths

79.5% support safer crossing points

56.8% want reduced traffic speed

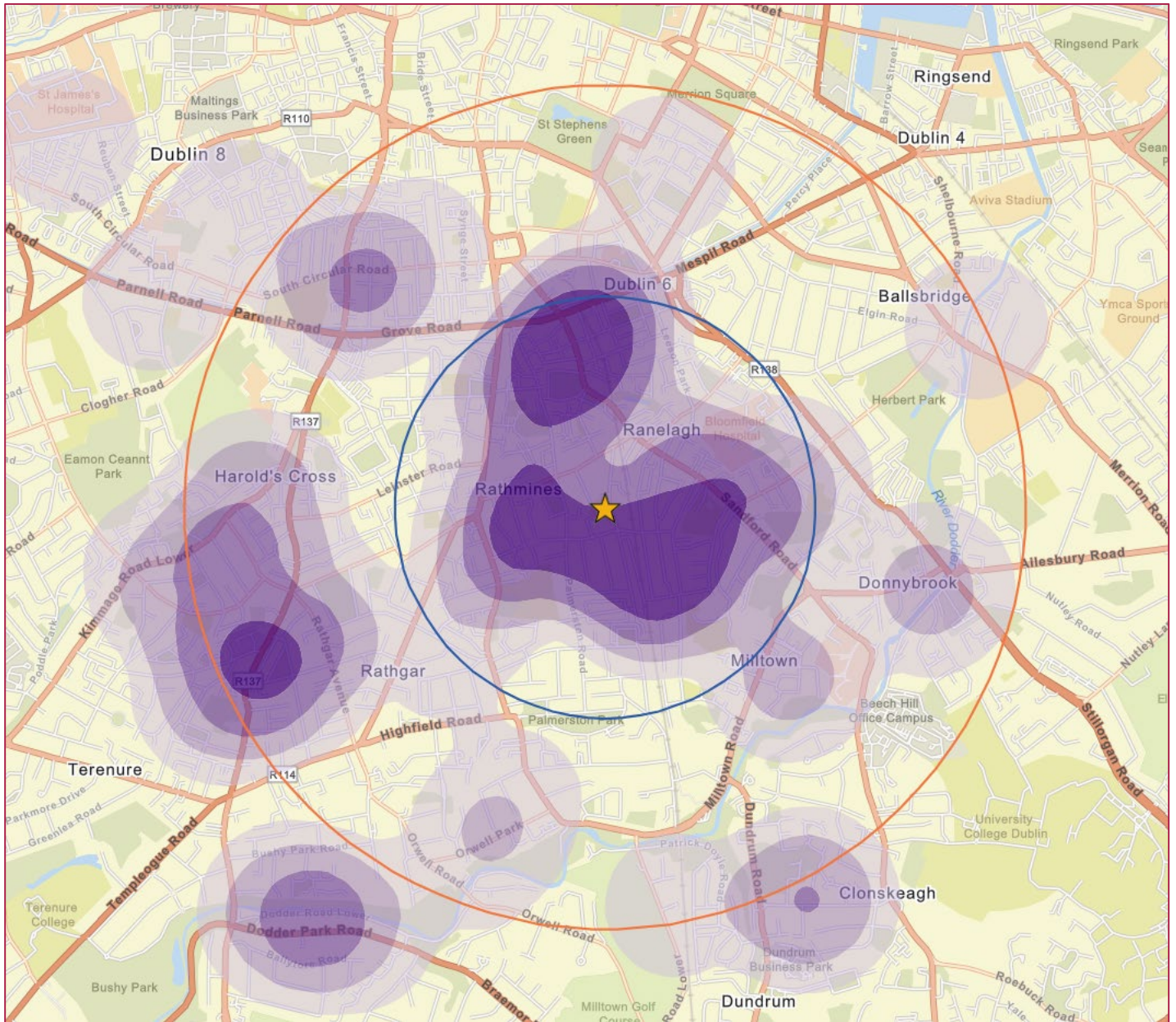
54.5% want fewer cars at the school gate
