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## St Fiachra's JNS - Parent Survey

The school distributed the Safe Routes to School survey to all parents, via their usual communications methods, during October 2021. Reminders were also issued. As part of the survey, parents were asked to indicate on a map where their school journey begins, as well as the modes by which students usually travel to school.

Responses received: 238
Students represented: $\quad 272=56.5 \%$ of school population (based on a total of $658^{*}$ )
