

- The school distributed the Safe Routes to School survey to all parents, via their usual communications methods, during October 2021. Reminders were also issued. As part of the survey, parents were asked to indicate on a map where their school journey begins, as well as the modes by which students usually travel to school.
- Responses received:159Students represented:174 = 67.4% of school population (based on a total of 258\*)
- The following pages display the results of the GIS analysis undertaken on the locations of students, using the ARCGIS online platform.


#### St Josephs Secondary School : Where students are travelling from






### St Josephs Secondary School: 1km & 2km radii with student density





#### St Josephs Secondary School: Reachable streets: Walking 15 minutes






#### School location

  - May not include existing permeability links


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
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
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
### St Josephs Secondary School – Modal split within 1 Km radius\*





\*58 students start their journey within a 1km radius of the school, accounting for 33.3% of students represented in the survey.


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
### St Josephs Secondary School – Modal split within 15 minutes walking\*





\*61 students start their journey within a 15-minute walk of the school, accounting for 35% of students represented in the survey.


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
\*90 students start their journey within a 20-minute walk of the school, accounting for 51.7% of students represented in the survey.
